#### ABOUT DORSET SOLDIERS

- Dorset Soldier castings are approximately 54mm tall and cast in white metal. Please ask the exact height if you want figures to fit in with other soldiers in your collection.
- Castings are supplied straight from the mould and will need flash cleaning with a knife and file before painting. I can quote to clean and assemble figures for you, if you prefer this.
- As many of the figures are made to collectors' own specifications, the style of figures varies from slight, traditional toys in the old 'Britains' format to detailed, chunky, near-models. I have tried to reflect this in the descriptions. Please contact me if you have an idea you wish to explore.
- Spare parts are available to repair broken old soldiers or convert figures in the lists.
- Painted figures can be produced from any figure in the lists or designed for you.
- Due to the lead content in the figures I do not supply figures to children under 14 years old.
